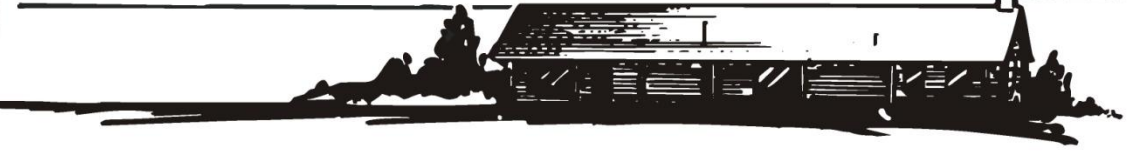

ANNUAL BRGC ELECTION MEETING DEC. 6, 2017

Election of officers and board members for the Billings Rod and Gun Club will take place at the annual meeting of the club membership **Dec. 6th**. By club rules, the board has 15 members, 4 of whom are elected by their respective divisions – archery, skeet/5-stand, sporting clays and rifle/pistol.
