CONSERVATION

ExxonMobil Pipeline has agreed to pay the State of Montana and several federal agencies \$12 million to settle natural resource damage claims resulting from a 2011 broken pipeline and resulting oil spill into the Yellowstone River at Laurel. The settlement, under federal Natural Resource Damage Assessment laws, was negotiated over the course of five years by attorneys for the company and various state and federal agencies. A public meeting is scheduled for Oct. 12 in Billings to discuss specific projects that will be accomplished to repair or mitigate damage to public natural resources.
