MASTER PLAN IMPROVEMENTS – UPDATE

The BRGC is pleased to announce that Master Plan Improvements to the Pistol range and Sporting Clays north course will continue into 2022. The work includes the addition of an 8th pistol bay, a new pistol range parking area east of the clubhouse and a new access road to the future 5 Stand and north course. The improvements are being funded by a FWP grant and contributions to the Master Plan fund via your membership dues.
