SPORTING CLAYS AND FIVE STAND

Sporting Clays Division had our final registered shoot on Saturday July 16th. We had a turnout of over forty shooters and had great targets set by Mike Davis. We have two charity shoots scheduled for August 2nd, and the Young Life Shoot scheduled for Saturday, August 20th. Charity or fun shoots can be scheduled for \$45 per person.

We will be having a Super Sporting League this fall on the north course starting on September 1st and continuing every Thursday through October 13th.

The north and main courses are open to members to shoot with prepaid target cards. Target cards can be purchased by appointment by calling Gary Smith 406-696-5458 or Mike Davis 406-698-6493.

Our target prices have been the same since 2017. Due to doubling of delivery costs and increased battery and fuel costs we are planning on increasing our target costs by 5 cents to 27 cents a target if ordering 1000 targets or over and 40 cents a target if ordering under 1000 targets. Our prices will change on December 1st of this year. We encourage you to plan and buy targets for your target cards before this date. We currently have 64 trap machines to maintain, and I doubt you can find a less expensive place to shoot sporting clays in this area.

Our next Sporting Clays Division Meeting will be Monday August 15th at 6:30pm.
