SPORTING CLAYS AND FIVE STAND

Sporting Clays is open to shooting for club members with prepaid target cards.

There will be having a fall super sporting league starting on Thursday September 1st and ending on Thursday October 13th. The cost is \$25 per night with \$5 going to cash prizes. Registration for individuals is from 3:30 to 5:30 with shooting to follow on the North Course. Fifty targets will be shot each night.
