Maybe by the time you are reading this, spring will be a little less abstract. One thing that has been happening on the pistol bays is people shooting the steel plate rack with their AR style rifles. This is not allowed and is clearly stated in the numerous signs outlining which firearms may be fired on which bays and what targets are to be shot with each type we of firearm. NO STEEL is to be shot with AR style rifles period, the high velocity 223 rounds destroy the plates, and you are damaging club property, subjecting yourself to board action, including revocation of your membership. As long as I am on a rant, how about everyone starts paying attention to where their muzzle is pointed? Maybe even make sure everyone on the range has protective eye wear on? And, what if all targets in the bays were placed to make sure that every bullet impacts a berm, instead of having them impact the floor of the range and skip over the berm. In other words, let's all of us put a little thought into what we are doing and make sure we are being safe and thoughtful of the responsibilities we assume when we discharge a firearm. As a responsible member of this fine club, please, respectfully confront those of your fellow members breaking our rules. SPORTING CLAYS AND FIVE STAND
