SPORTING CLAYS AND FIVE STAND

There will be a Sporting Clays Tutorial on Saturday April 1 starting at 10:00 am. for members and teenage family members who are interested in learning about Sporting Clays. We will be having a one hour talk about safety, proper gun fit, and our wi-fi target card system followed by a live fire shooting exercise at basic targets.
