## UPCOMING PISTOL RANGE CLOSURE JULY 24-30

As a reminder, the pistol range will be closed to member use from July 24 through July 30 while BRGC hosts the USPSA Area 1 practical shooting championship. Match setup will occur on July 24-26 with competition on July 27-30. This range closure affects only the pistol range and the Sporting Clays north course; all other Club ranges will remain open. This one-time match will host over 400 competitors from around the nation; we appreciate your patience as we host this event and encourage you to come to the range and watch some of the best shooters in the world.

When we place a new target on the bale it is moved to a different position to lengthen the life of the bale. Painting a dot and not replacing the target reduces the life of the bale.
