ARCHERY

To foster more involvement with the upkeep of our targets on the walking courses. Should you find a target or targets with shot out faces, we will have a container at the club house which will have targets and hammers that shooters can use to replace the worn targets. The hammer is used to pull the spikes holding the target and driving the spikes in on the new target. Please remember to return the hammer.
