SPORTING CLAYS AND FIVE STAND

The main course, north course, and 5-Stand will be open for shooting over the winter months weather permitting. The only shotgun ammunition allowed on the course is a maximum weight of one and one/eighth ounce lead shot size 7.5 or smaller (8,8.5, or 9). Carpet is being glued on each station in the new 5-Stand.Do not use if the edges are not stapled down and secure.
