PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Spring is just around the corner, and that means the return of construction season to Montana. This year, Billings area construction will likely include finishing the inner belt loop connecting Zimmerman Trail with Wicks Lane. This new road runs close to the BRGC property on the north and may result in significant development over the next decade or so. We, as members of BRGC, need to do what we can to make sure that we are good neighbors going forward. One of the reasons for the improvements to the rifle and pistol range berms over the last few years is to minimize the chance of an errant round leaving our range. One thing that is important for everyone using those ranges to understand is that targets must be placed against a suitable backstop. This means a backer board on those ranges where they are available or placing your target against an end or side berm in the field bays. Doing so will help prevent bullets from ricocheting off the bay floor and leaving our property. We, as shooters, are responsible for every bullet that leaves the barrel and we need to take measures that none of them land where we don't want them to. Matt Waite (contact the Club President)

SPORTING CLAYS AND FIVE STAND

The winter 5 stand Buckle shoot will continue on Saturdays through March 23. Squads start shooting at 9:30, Show up to sign up or email clays division for sign ups... You must show up 20 minutes ahead of time!

Sporting Clays Division is holding a Sporting Clays Tutorial on March 30 for people interested in learning how to shoot Sporting Clays. This course is for people interested in learning how to shoot Sporting Clays and experienced shooters who want to learn how to use the course at BRGC. The cost is \$15 per person which includes a box of shells and targets. You can bring your shotgun, unloaded, and in a case along with eye and ear protection if you have it. The main course, north course, and 5-Stand will be open for shooting over the winter months weather permitting. The only shotgun ammunition allowed on the course is a maximum weight of one and one/eighth ounce lead shot size 7.5 or smaller (8,8.5, or 9).

The Main and North Courses are open to shooting to members who have a prepaid target card. Target cards can be purchased at the sporting Clays Clubhouse during a scheduled appointment with either Gary Smith (696-5450), Mike Davis (698-6493) or Phil Gill (696- 3875).
