PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

With the arrival of spring weather, most of us will be spending more time on the range. This is a good time to ask yourself if you are prepared for a medical emergency. Do you have a first aid kit in your range bag? Do you carry a tourniquet or a complete trauma kit? Just as important, do you know how to use it? Do you know where to find an AED? Do you know the street address of the Club to communicate it to first responders? We all hope that we do not have to deal with an emergency on the range, but hope is not an effective plan. I'd encourage everyone reading this message to give some thought to carrying basic first aid supplies with you on the range and to taking a first aid or CPR class. Several local providers are offering free or low-cost classes.

There is an AED device located inside the door of the main clubhouse; this door is always unlocked, and the AED is available for use by anyone needing it. These slick devices are easy to use and will guide you through the process.

SPORTING CLAYS AND FIVE STAND

The 2024 Spring/Summer League will be on Thursday evenings and run for 12 weeks starting on April 4th and ending on June 20th. Fun Shoot and Awards Dinner will take place on Thursday, June 27. League is typically limited to the first 80 shooters that register. League Member Fees are \$40 per person and teams may include up to 6 shooters. All Member League Fees go toward league-ending prizes and awards night dinner. Nightly target fees have remained unchanged for several years now and are \$20 for juniors (Under 18) and \$35 for adults per 100 targets (with \$5 going towards the Lewis Class payout). There will be a Lewis class payout every week with typically four "Lewis class" payouts.

We will have different target presentations each week, thanks to our many volunteers. If you would like to volunteer for weekly tasks such as garbage pickup at each shooting station; filling trap machines and course setting; contact our Clays Division President. Performing these weekly tasks allows an opportunity to pay for your clays league shoot fees.

Though teams may have between 3 and 6 shooters, only the top three scores will count for each night. All new teams that have never shot sporting clays will have a special season-end award.

The Main and North Courses are open to shooting to members who have a prepaid target card. Target cards can be purchased at the sporting Clays Clubhouse during a scheduled appointment with either Gary Smith (696-5450), Mike Davis (698-6493) or Phil Gill (696-3875).
