# MEMBERSHIP REMINDERS

As the ranges get busier for the summer, review and follow all posted range rules. And remember 1) stay on designated bermed ranges, shooting stations, roads or trails; 2) dogs must be kept under control at all times; owners are responsible to clean up and dispose of all animal waste; 3) abide by day pass rules when bringing in an adult guest; see exemptions on fees; 4) have your membership card with you while on club grounds; and 5) use your gate card at all access gates even if the gate is raised; do not piggyback on the vehicle ahead of you.
