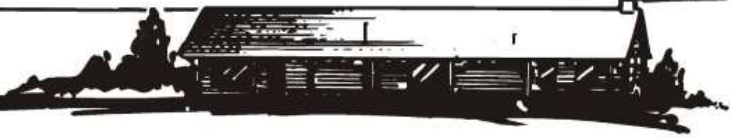

I'd like to use my space this month to highlight some of the improvements at the club over the last year. The new Lewallen-Trythall Five Stand Building on the Sporting Clays North Course is complete and provides an all-weather facility for shotgun events and casual shooting. We have taken a more proactive approach to road maintenance to stay ahead of the washboards that form on the grades. The club has also moved to an option to pay for membership renewals electronically.

Over the coming year, more improvements are on the horizon. If the applied-for grant funding comes through, we plan to add a vault toilet to the east end of the pistol range, rebuild the cart path on the Sporting Clays course, and add a cover to the western archery range near the main clubhouse. The Planning and Administration Committee has been hard at work identifying and prioritizing Club improvements. The Board works diligently to maintain and improve the Club while still being good stewards of the money you all pay in membership dues.
