SKEET AND TRAP

The Skeet and Trap facility is currently open on Sundays from 10AM to 1PM to members and the public. Skeet fields 1, 2, 3, and the Trap field are available every day. Tokens can be purchased for cash or check from the desk worker on Sundays, or from the token vending machine located on the east wall of the building at any time.

The token vending machine currently accepts cash payment or credit card payment. Tokens are \$6 each when purchased with cash. When a cashless transaction is used, each transaction using a credit card/Pay Pal/Google Pay/etc. will vend 5 tokens for \$30. In addition, a service charge of \$1.50 will be charged for each transaction. Please note that on November 1, 2025, the token machine will be revised to credit card transactions only.

Skeet Night League will run for 7 weeks starting November 4, 2025, and runs through December 16, 2025.
