This includes mechanical devices that simulate fully automatic fire such as bump stocks, binary triggers, forced reset triggers, etc. This rule is in place to minimize the potential for rounds leaving the Club grounds; not only is there danger in rounds leaving the range, but a neighbor finding a spent bullet in the yard has shut down more than one shooting range. We have a great facility here; please abide by the posted Club rules and do not risk losing it.
