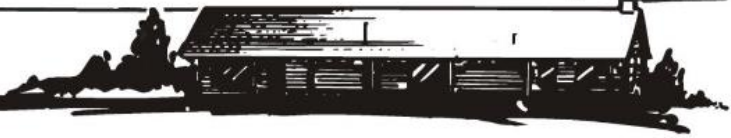

We are closing in on the beginning of summer and events at the Club are in full swing.

With all the activity at the Club it is time for a reminder that the speed limit on Club roads is 15 mph. Road work is one of the costliest maintenance items in the Club's annual budget and sticking to the 15 mph limit while taking it easy on hills and curves, will help the road last as long as possible.

A reminder for folks on the rifle and pistol ranges: Club rules prohibit the use of fully automatic firearms and any device that simulates such fire. This includes bump stocks, binary triggers, and forced reset triggers. This is becoming an increasingly common violation. The Club takes the posted rules seriously, and violation may result in disciplinary action.

SPORTING CLAYS AND FIVE STAND

The next Sporting Clays and Five Stand Division Meeting will be held on Monday June 15, 2026, at 6PM.

Rules concerning the new trail:

1.) No vehicles on the trail other than side by sides, ATVs, and golf carts. Vehicles other than these constitute a Range Rule Violation. 2.) During tournaments and league: ATVs, side by sides, and golf carts are one way traffic only. Once you finish up on the last stand (#14), please return to the clubhouse area via the main club road.

We ask that you continue to stay off the hydro seeded areas. We have put magnets on six-foot dowels that are stored at stations. It's not perfect, but it will pick up most hulls. We ask that you use the magnets to pick up what hulls you can without stepping on the hydro seeded areas.
